Guidelines for Contributors

• Manuscripts should be sent along with the authorization letter in favour of

the convener that it may be published after necessary editing and the copyright shall remain with the College. Manuscript should also accompany a brief Resume of the writer on separate sheet.

• **Manuscripts** should normally be of around 2,000 words (To an extent of 5 to 6 A-4 size pages, typed single space).

Manuscripts should be submitted in hard copy & soft copy with the cover page bearing only the title of the paper and author(s)'s name(s), designation(s), official address(es), phone/fax number(s) and e-mail address(es).

• Abstracts All the manuscripts should include an abstract of about 100 to 200 words.

• **References** Place the references at the end of the manuscript .The list should mention only those sources actually cited in the text. References in MLA style sheet strictly. No foot Notes. Title of Books should be in Italics and Titles of Articles and Journals should be in quotation.

• Marathi / Hindi : Articles only typed in Pagemaker, APS software, Font D.V. Prakash, Font Size 14 will be accepted
